

BOAT HAUL-OUT AND STORAGE CONTRACT

FULL PAYMENT PRIOR TO LAUNCHING OR REMOVAL OF LIFTED VESSEL - NO EXCEPTIONS
(It is advisable to book early for optimal scheduling)

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Reservation and Timing:

You have reserved a specific day and time for haul-out. Punctuality is crucial; failure to be on time may result in cancellation or postponement by us.

Rescheduling, within the same year, is allowed up to 48 hours before the scheduled time. A US\$250 penalty will be charged otherwise.

Any cancellation will result in the loss of the US\$250, non-refundable, deposit.

2. Boats going to the Work Yard:

Specify the launch date, updatable in writing until the haul-out date.

Confirmations and date changes must be in writing.

Failure to launch within 5 working days of the agreed date incurs a re-planning fee of US\$300 unless the delay is due to our team.

3. Boats going to Storage:

Specify the direct launch or relocation date, updateable until the haul-out.

Confirmations and changes must be in writing.

Failure to adhere to the launch or relocation date by more than 5 working days incurs a re-planning fee of US\$300 unless the delay is due to our team.

If relocation to the Work Yard, a launch date must be declared in writing at the time of the relocation, with the same penalties for delays,

RESPONSIBILITIES AND RESTRICTIONS

4. Boat Lifting and Placement:

Boat owners must instruct the lift operator on trailer pad placement before lifting.

Varadero assumes no responsibility for damage to any part of the boat.

Cradle arm or prop movement is only permitted by Varadero boatyard staff.

5. Boatyard Site and Maintenance:

Boat owners are responsible for maintaining a clean boatyard site.

Prohibited activities include dry sanding of anti-fouling without Varadero's prior authorization.

\$100.00 penalty for non-compliance.

Any potentially hazardous work requires prior notification and approval by Varadero's BoatYard Manager.

6. Contractors and Refueling:

Contractors must read and sign Varadero Marina terms and conditions.

All contractors incur a 15% commission fee.

Refueling on the hardstand is only allowed with prior arrangement through Varadero using Maso/Varadero fuel.

7. General Rules:

No unauthorized vehicles are allowed in the boatyard.

Long-term vessel payments are due monthly by the 1st business day, with late payment interest of 1.5% after the 10th.

8. Insurance Declaration:

The customer declares that the vessel is fully insured.

9. Full Payment Acknowledgment:

The Customer acknowledges and accepts the terms and conditions, including the attached Varadero Marina terms and conditions and the Haul-out & Relaunch Guide.
