

Dr's Orders Description/Inventory

Galley and Water Systems

The U-shaped galley is comfortable to use at the dock or while underway. Stove with three burners and two aluminum propane tanks – one on-line and one in reserve. The stove is gimbaled and is allowed to swing to accommodate any sailing angle. The galley also includes a microwave and separate refrigerator and freezer. The freezer and refrigerator both open on top and the refrigerator also have front door access.

Sails and Rigging

Drs Orders has a full batten main sail, with lazy jacks and is stored in Doyle cradle sail cover. The control lines for the traveler are accessible from inside the cockpit. The large Lewmar ST-50 winches on the genoa sheets and the ST-44/30 winches on the halyards make her easy to single hand. All Standing rigging was redone at Grenada Marine in 2020 All running rigging was redone in Bonaire with Marco Wildeboer using Premium Ropes including Stirotex Soft Shackles and Stirotex cored lines for each halyard on the boat. All new in 2022

Cockpit and Deck

The cockpit is usable and enjoyable day and night. The cockpit cushions and double aft deck cushions make the cockpit area very comfortable. The custom dodger and bimini provide shade and weather protection.

Owners Comments

This boat was never chartered and we are only the third owners. We spent the last few years in the ABC Islands refitting her a little each year to make life more comfortable. With the charging system (solar panels) and the LiFePO4 batteries, we can run regular sized 120v house fans all day and night on the boat to keep it cool, run the water maker in the morning and still have the batteries fully recharged by noon. We jokingly offer to run extension cords to our neighbors while at anchor. She also sails like a dream. We comfortably pushed 7 to 8 knots sailing from Carriacou to Curacao the entire way. However, due to health reasons, we are forced to sale and retire from sailing. We are parting with our home grudgingly and have had her in storage for the last year hoping something would change medically.

Dr's Orders is completely fitted for living aboard with all the necessary items from a fully stocked kitchen to way too many tools and spare parts for emergencies. Just pack your clothes, if you need them, and begin sailing.
